ADDENDUM NO. 2

This addendum forms a part of and modifies the IFB documents as noted below. Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the Bid Documentation form. Failure to do so may subject Visswe to disqualification.

Questions have arisen regarding the type of equipment/method for the actual removal of the vessels from Gravina Island and whether a barge off-loading motorized vehicles to assist with the loading of the derelicts/debris onto the barge would be allowed.

State Department of Transportation, State Department of Natural Resources and the US Army Corps of Engineers, with the caveat listed below*, do not require any permitting for this project.

As long as there are no changes in the elevations of substrate by moving soil with equipment or backfilling any areas below the high tide line, no permit would be required.
