Grant Scoring Criteria

1. **Filling Gaps in Service within the Community (30 points)**
 - **High Impact (30 points):** The project addresses significant gaps in opioid remediation services that are currently unmet within the community.
 - **Moderate Impact (20 points):** The project addresses some gaps in services but may overlap with existing programs.
 - **Low Impact (10 points):** The project has minimal impact on filling service gaps or duplicates existing services.
2. **Number of Individuals Targeted (25 points)**
 - **High Reach (25 points):** The project targets a large number of individuals, significantly increasing access to opioid remediation services.
 - **Moderate Reach (15 points):** The project targets a moderate number of individuals, providing substantial but not widespread access.
 - **Low Reach (5 points):** The project targets a small number of individuals, with limited impact on overall access.
3. **Agency's Capacity to Implement the Project (25 points)**
 - **High Capacity (25 points):** The agency has a strong track record, sufficient resources, and expertise to successfully implement the project.
 - **Moderate Capacity (15 points):** The agency has some experience and resources but may require additional support to implement the project.
 - **Low Capacity (5 points):** The agency has limited experience and resources, raising concerns about their ability to implement the project effectively.
4. **Alignment with Core Strategies and Approved Uses (20 points)**
 - **Strong Alignment (20 points):** The project aligns closely with multiple core strategies and approved uses as outlined in the guidelines.
 - **Moderate Alignment (10 points):** The project aligns with some core strategies and approved uses but may not address all key areas.
 - **Weak Alignment (5 points):** The project has minimal alignment with the core strategies and approved uses.
