This addendum forms a part of and modifies the Invitation for Bid (IFB) as follows. Failure to acknowledge the addendum in the space provided in the proposal may result in a rejection of your bid.

Questions and Clarifications:

Question No. 1: **Universal Air Connection (UAC).** Would the department prefer to have a 3' quick fill System hose in pouch provided for each SCBA to allow Firefighters to allow trans-filling between SCBA wearers?

Answer No. 1: NO.

Question No. 2: **Cylinders.** Would the department like the option of either the Quick Connect remote option or standard CGA remote option to facilitate the attaching and removing the SCBA cylinder from the SCBA?

Answer No. 2: The Quick Connect Remote Option.

Question No. 3: **PASS / Integrated Thermal Imaging Camera.** Will an integrated thermal imager be integrated into the PASS of each of the SCBA's?

Answer No. 3: YES.

Question No. 4: **Thermal Imager Warranty Option.** There are three options available for the warranty on the integrated thermal imager when integrated into the SCBA PASS device, which option should be provide?

- 1- 5-year warranty (standard)
- 2- 10-year extended warranty
- 3- 15-year extended warranty

Answer No. 4: Standard Warranty option.

Question No. 5: **Emergency Escape Breathing Support System.** Would the department like to have a buddy breather (emergency escape breathing support system) provided for each SCBA to allow Firefighters to interconnect in an emergency with both male and female connections?

Answer No. 5: YES.

Question NO. 6: **Carrier and Harness.** Would the Department like the SCBA carrier to have either the standard shoulder straps or the serviceable tunnel shoulder straps?

Answer No. 6: The Serviceable Tunnel Straps.

Question No. 7: Would the Department like the optional chest strap incorporated into either style shoulder strap configuration?

Answer No. 7: Yes. The Chest Strap.

Question No. 8: **Power Source.** Would the Department like the power source equipped with the Alkaline battery pack (includes six C cell batteries) or the rechargeable power source with the lithium ion battery pack?

Answer No. 8: Alkaline Battery Pack.

Question No. 9: **Cylinder Pack.** Does the Department require only one cylinder/pack or should spare cylinders be quoted as well?

Answer No. 9: One cylinder per pack and 28 spare bottles for a total of 56 are required to be provided in the bid price.

Question No. 10: **Peripheral components.** On change-overs, there are usually items that are required to help make the transition, such as Posi-Chek software for G1's, repair tools for servicing the SCBA's, Quick Fill attachments for your cascade fill station (if using the QR fitting on cylinders), and fit testing equipment. Are any of the additional transition components required?

Answer No. 10: No additional components required.
