One (1) new positive test result for COVID-19 has been identified through the traveler testing site at the Ketchikan airport. This individual arrived on June 13th, and was instructed to quarantine until receiving test results. This individual was traveling to Ketchikan as a visitor and is staying in Ketchikan.

This person has been contacted by a health care provider with notification of the positive result, has been directed to isolate, and is being monitored by healthcare providers.

Public Health officials have been notified and will begin the contact investigation today and reach out to any person who may have come into contact with this individual. Public Health will notify and quarantine additional persons as appropriate. Through the contact investigation, Public Health will direct testing of persons that meet criteria based on contact with any confirmed case of COVID-19. Individuals who meet the criteria are being tested in accordance with CDC and State of Alaska priorities.

This case brings the cumulative COVID-19 case count, including travelers, to 23, and the number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan to 20. Of the 20 cases, 16 have recovered.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop symptoms, such as a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing, call your healthcare provider for medical advice or use the Testing Hotline and call 247-TEST (8378). The EOC Drive-Up COVID-19 Testing Clinic will be open each Wednesday and Thursday from 11 am to 1 pm at Berth 3.
