One new positive test result for COVID-19 has been identified today through a local health clinic. This case brings the cumulative COVID-19 case count, including travelers, to 40. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is 36. Of the 36 cases, 6 are still active, and 30 have recovered.

This individual is a Ketchikan resident who sought testing at a local clinic. This individual is symptomatic, has been notified of the positive test result, has been directed to isolate, and is being monitored by healthcare providers. The source of how the virus was contracted is under investigation.

Public Health officials have begun the contact investigation and will reach out to any person who may have come into contact with this individual. Public Health will notify and quarantine additional persons as appropriate. Through the contact investigation, Public Health will direct testing of persons that meet criteria based on contact with any confirmed case of COVID-19. Individuals who meet the criteria are being tested in accordance with CDC and State of Alaska priorities.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop any symptoms, no matter how minor—such as a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing—call your healthcare provider for medical advice or use the Testing Hotline and call 247-TEST (8378).
