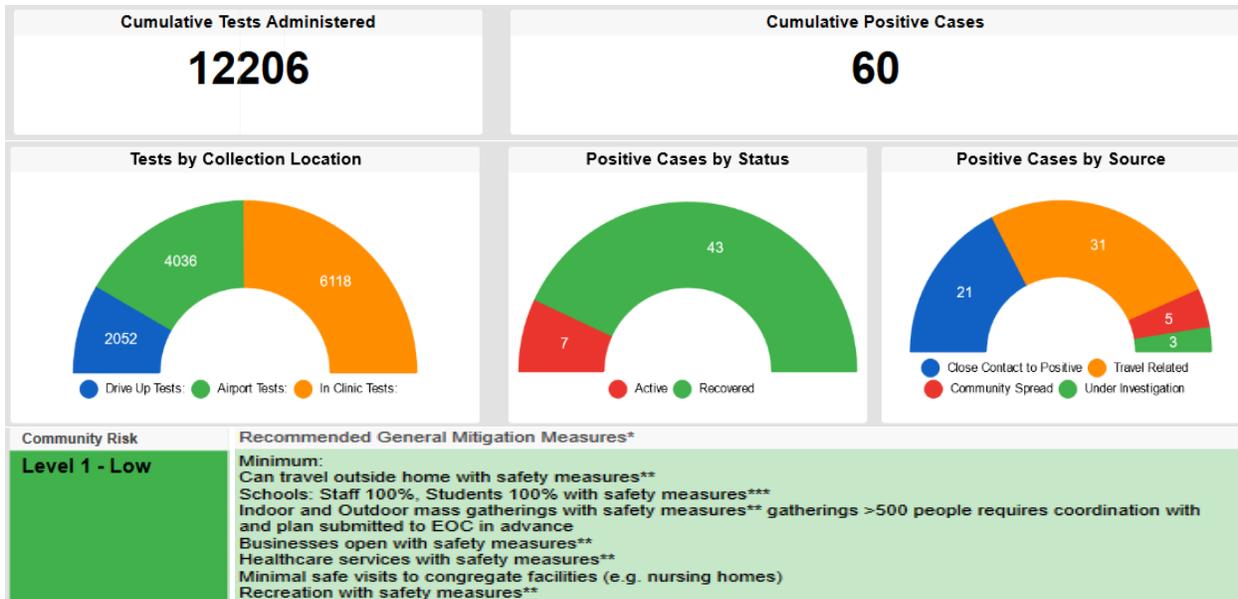

Two new positive test results for COVID-19 have been identified today through the traveler testing site. These individuals are Ketchikan residents who are members of the same household and returned to Ketchikan on August 18th. They have been notified of the positive test result, have been directed to isolate, and are being monitored by healthcare providers. They are both currently asymptomatic. Public Health officials have begun the contact investigations and will reach out to any person who may have come into contact with either of these individuals. Public Health will notify and quarantine additional persons as appropriate.

Regarding the three positive KIC-related cases announced on Tuesday, the source of cases is still under investigation. All of the people who came into close contact with the three positive cases have been notified by Public Health. If you have questions or concerns related to these cases, please call Public Health at 225-4350.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop any symptoms, no matter how minor—such as a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing—call your healthcare provider for medical advice or use the Testing Hotline and call 247-TEST (8378).

Today's cases bring the cumulative COVID-19 case count, including travelers, to 60. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is 50. Of the 50 cases, 7 are still active, and 43 have recovered.
