**1. Did your non-profit provide services to residents of the Ketchikan Gateway Borough in 2019? Please describe the services provided in Ketchikan with specific information on the number of individuals served and the impact of your organization on the community:**

Ketchikan Wrestling Club (KWC) provides coaching and support to youth in the community of Ketchikan, Alaska, who are between five to eighteen years old. KWC is a charter formed to support youth wrestling in Ketchikan. KWC helps with fundraising, buying equipment, traveling expenses, youth participation in local and non-local wrestling camps.

Wrestling builds character, teaches youth how to overcome obstacles, and that success is earned through hard work and determination. Youth learn to handle their emotions, respect authority, and the importance of being a good teammate.

COVID-19 impacts to KWC and the youth who participate in the 2020-2021 Wrestling season are

- COVID-19 Testing for youth and volunteers traveling out of town
- KWC will also have additional expenses for PPE, sanitizing & cleaning supplies, thermometers for symptom checking, etc.
- Schoenbar wrestling team fundraises travel funds because it is not funded by the district. They were not able to finish raising the funds to cover the cost of last season travel due to closure of schools. the canceled fundraiser was expected to generate \$8,000
- The Student athletes are not allowed to fundraise this year.
- Kayhi and Schoenbar wrestling teams fundraise over \$40,000 a year.

The Ketchikan Wrestling Club requests a total of \$20,000 to provide equipment, travel and testing expenses, local wrestling camps, and PPE to youth who participate in the 2020-2021 wrestling season.
