One new positive case of Covid-19 was identified in Ketchikan today. This individual is a recent traveler who became symptomatic after returning, and sought testing at a local health clinic. This individual has been notified of the positive test result, has been directed to isolate, and is being monitored by healthcare providers. Public Health have begun contact investigation and will reach out to any person who may have come into contact with this individual. Public Health will notify and quarantine additional persons as appropriate.

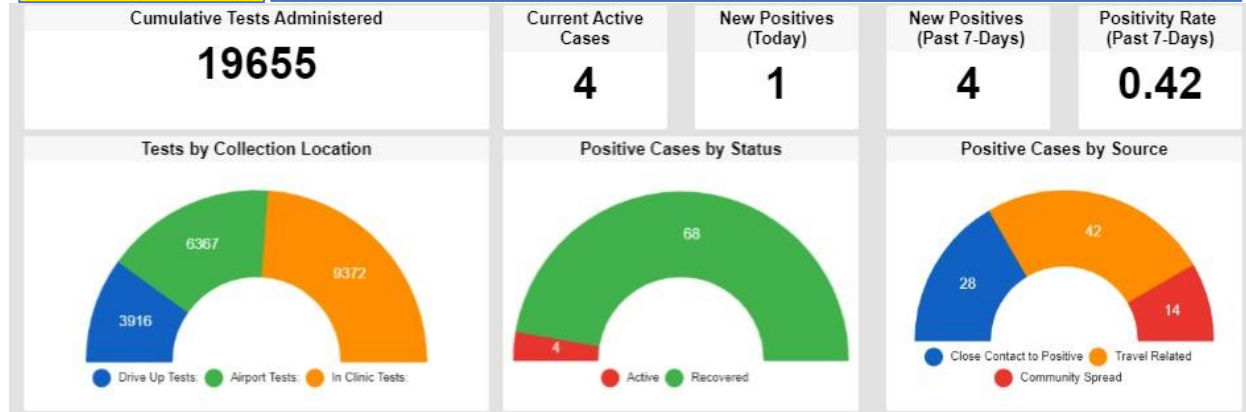

Free Covid-19 Testing is available at the Berth 3 Drive Up facility during the hours of 9:30-11:30 am and 2:30-4:30 pm, Tuesday through Saturday.

Today’s case brings the cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, to 84. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is 72. Of the 72 cases, 4 are still active, and 68 have recovered.
