## **Cape Fox Lodge Update on COVID**

**Ketchikan, AK** – Yesterday, Cape Fox Lodge informed everyone that three individuals have tested positive for COVID-19 recently and that all three individuals are now in isolation. After four more individuals tested positive, after consulting with the EOC we decided to conduct mass testing of all employees. As a result of the mass testing, nine more individuals tested positive. All 13 individuals who have tested positive for COVID are in isolation.

While we understand this sounds alarming, please be assured every individual who has tested positive is in isolation and we continue to work closely with the Emergency Operations Center and Public Health to monitor this situation closely. Our primary goal is to maintain the health and safety of our friends and neighbors. We are a strong community who will get through this together by being apart for now.

We are also taking the additional precaution of keeping all our locations including; Cape Fox Lodge, Bar Harbor Ale House, Dockside Galley, 108 Tap House & Burger Bar, and Sweet Mermaids closed until 11am Friday, November 6, 2020. Finally, we will be testing all our employees again on Thursday, November 5<sup>th</sup> to ensure that when we do open our businesses again, it is safe for our friends and neighbors.

It is with sadness we inform everyone of the news, but we also want to assure you we are taking the necessary steps and precautions. We will see you again, but until we are confident our friends and neighbors will be safe, our doors may be closed, while our hearts remain open. We look forward to being able to see you again soon. Everyone's health and safety are our number one priority. Stay safe and wear a mask, we are in this together.
