There were four new cases of Covid-19 identified in Ketchikan today. These were two separate households of two individuals each, who were symptomatic and sought testing at local providers. The source for all four cases has been determined to be close contact to a known positive(s). These individuals have been notified of the positive test results, have been directed to isolate, and are being monitored by healthcare providers. Public Health has begun the contact investigations and will be in touch with anyone who may have been in close contact with these individuals.

The two positive individuals from the same household identified on Thursday were also determined to be due to close contact to a known positive.

If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and develop any symptoms, no matter how minor—such as a fever, cough, difficulty breathing, headache, or body ache—call your healthcare provider for medical advice or use the Testing Hotline and call 247-TEST (8378).


Free Covid-19 Testing is available at the Berth 3 Drive Up facility during the hours of 9:30-11:30 am and 2:30-4:30 pm, Tuesday through Saturday. Please note that the testers are now in a solid wooden building and are no longer using the pop-up tents.

Today's case brings the cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, to 96. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is 84 Of the 84 cases, 12 are still active, and 72 have recovered.
