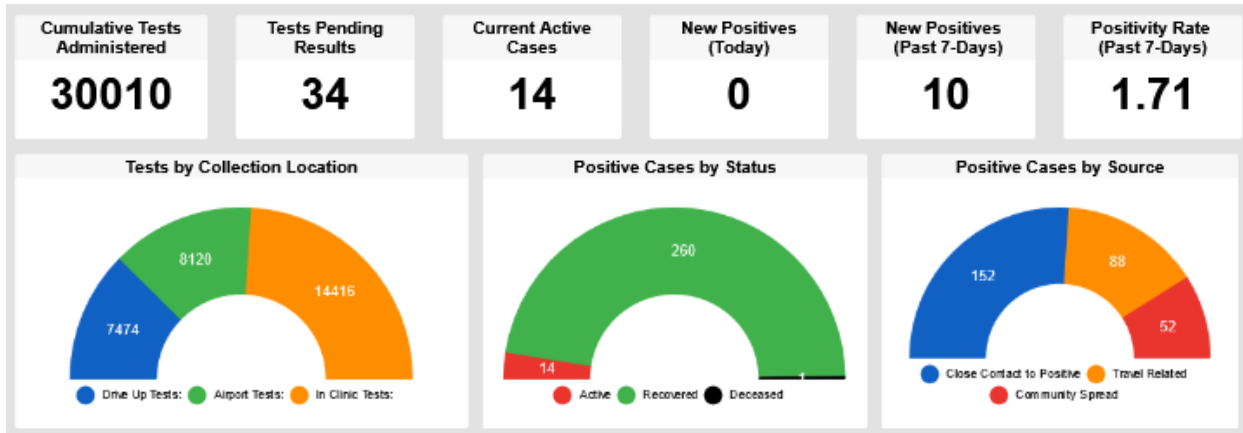
EOC COVID-19 CASE COUNT UPDATE: NO NEW CASES

There were no new cases of COVID-19 reported in Ketchikan today. The case pending investigation from January 14th was determined to be close contact to a known positive case. The contact investigation is complete.

The total cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, remains at 292. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is **275**. Of the 275 cases, there are **14** active, **1** deceased¹, and **260** recovered.



The Community Risk Level is at Level 2 – Moderate.
