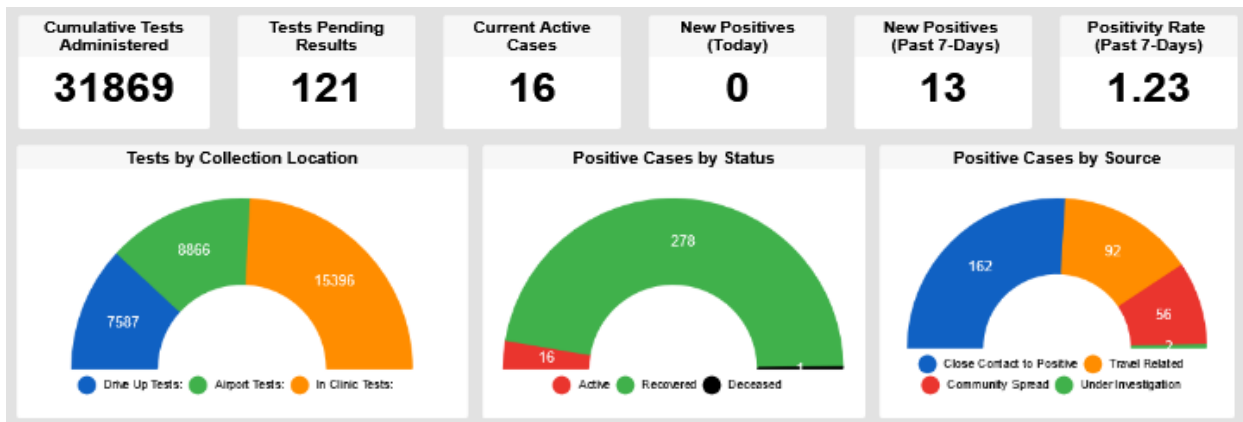
### EOC COVID-19 COVID-19 CASE COUNT UPDATE: NO NEW CASES

#### For Immediate Release

There were no positive COVID-19 cases reported in Ketchikan today. The two pending cases from January 29<sup>th</sup> continue to be under investigation.

The total cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, remains 312. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is **295**. Of the 295 cases, there are **16** active, **1** deceased<sup>1</sup>, and **278** recovered.



#### The Community Risk Level is at Level 2 – Moderate.
