### EOC COVID-19 CASE COUNT UPDATE: NO NEW CASES

#### For Immediate Release

There were no new cases of COVID-19 reported in Ketchikan today. The cases pending from February 4, 5, and 6, remain under investigation.

The total cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, is 339. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is **321**. Of the 321 cases, there are **28** active, **2** deceased<sup>1</sup>, and **291** recovered.
