**EOC COVID-19 CASE COUNT UPDATE:  
TWO NEW CASES and ONE HOSPITALIZATION**



**For Immediate Release**

There were two new cases of COVID-19 reported in Ketchikan today. Both of the individuals are symptomatic. The source of the virus and the contacts are under investigation. During the contact investigation, Public Health will work with the positive individuals to reach out to anyone who may be a close contact and instruct them to quarantine.

There was one individual admitted to the COVID-19 Unit at PeaceHealth Medical Center today.

Today's cases bring the total cumulative Covid-19 case count, including travelers, to 352. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is **334**. Of the 334 cases, there are **32** active, **2** deceased<sup>1</sup>, and **300** recovered.
