

There is one new case of COVID-19 reported in Ketchikan. This individual is currently asymptomatic and the source of the virus was determined to be community spread. The contact investigation is complete.

The positive case reported on April 1st was determined to be community spread.

The total cumulative case count, including travelers, is 405. The number of positive cases of individuals residing or staying in Ketchikan is **387**. Of the 387 cases, there are **8** active, **2** deceased, and **377** recovered.



The Community Risk Level is at Level 1 - Low
